I've been showing and breeding Ragdolls for 6 years but have been involved with animal breeding and showing for over 30 years. We showed Quarter Horses and Appaloosa, and Australian Shepherd dogs. We have shown at the National and World level. And for many years produced Nationally pointed Horse shows, where participants can qualify for the World championships.

I was on the board of directors for a national dog association for 10 years. I understand the difficulties with getting things done, but have been successful in those endeavors.

We have only traditional lines in our Ragdolls. I have a commitment to the Blue eyes Pointed Ragdolls ONLY. I have never owned and would Never own or breed a BEW or a solid.

I realize they are in the registry and that can't be changed. That is unfortunate.

I do have an issue with how the Breeders of these solids, markets them as rare and expensive, I believe this hurts all of the Ragdoll breed. Solids create confusion for the public. A Ragdoll in a rescue, gets rescued first as a recognized pure bred. A solid does not. Most look like an average long haired mix breed cat.

I show and have several RW's and Supremes. I don't get to as many shows as I would like due to our current location and the fact that there are No TICA shows in my state.

That will change in the future.

I am retired and have the time to devote to this issue.
